



## ICE / ICES MUTUAL EXEMPTION AGREEMENT

The requirements for ICES Members and Fellows wishing to apply to ICE are given below.

Applicants must have been an ICES Corporate member for 2 years and have worked in the built environment for 12 years. Applications can be made at any time after 13th September 2004.

Please submit the following documents:

- Membership Application form ICE 2105(A)
- A detailed CV
- A copy of your academic qualifications
- Your CPD record showing at least 5 days CPD per a year over the last 5 years
- 2 x Sponsor's questionnaire ICE 2106(A)
- An administration fee of £75 (cheque made payable to The Institution of Civil Engineers)

### Guidance note on the submission requirements for membership – MICE

#### Sponsor Requirements

All applications for membership must be supported by at least 2 ICE Sponsors who must be current Members or Fellows of at least 3 years standing and at the same grade or above that for which the applicant is applying.

#### Timescale

Applications are considered by the Exemption and Recognition Panel. The panel normally meets six times a year and you will be advised of the outcome within four weeks of the Panel Meeting.
