

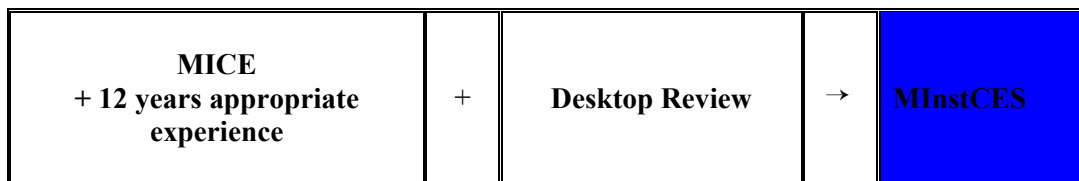


ICES / ICE MUTUAL EXEMPTION AGREEMENT

ICES is pleased to announce that the Institution welcomes applications for membership from ICE Members and Fellows.

Applicants must have been an ICE Member for 2 years and have worked in the built environment for 12 years. Applications can be made at any time after 13th September 2004.

Membership principles



Applicants must have been a MICE for at least 2 years and have worked in the built environment for 12 years.

ICE Fellows may be eligible to apply for Fellowship of the ICES. The application process is the same as for Member.

Make applications directly to ICES

For ICE members who are interested to apply, please submit the following documents:

- Membership Application form ICES 101/2004
- A detailed CV (2000 words)
- A copy of your academic qualifications
- Your CPD record showing at least 5 days CPD per a year over the last 2 years
- Signatures of 2 Sponsors
- An administration fee of £75 (cheque made payable to ICES)

Sponsor Requirements

All applications for membership must be supported by at least 2 Sponsors (2 ICES or 1 ICES plus one ICE) who must be current Members or Fellows of at least 3 years standing and at the same grade or above that for which the applicant is applying.

Timescale

Applications are considered by the Education, Training and Membership Committee. The Committee normally meets 4 times a year and you will be advised of the outcome within four weeks of the Committee meeting.
